WHEREAS, CAPFA Resolution 2020-21A *Resolution to Approve the Constitution and Bylaws for the Administrative and Professional (A/P) Faculty Senate* was approved by University Council on February 15, 2021 and approved by the Board of Visitors on March 22, 2021; and

WHEREAS, CAPFA Resolution 2020-21B *Joint Resolution to Revise Shared Governance at Virginia Tech* was approved by University Council on February 15, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the A/P Faculty Senate Constitution and Bylaws outline the leadership, membership, and role of the A/P Faculty Senate; and

WHEREAS, there is wide recognition of the complexity of the university's governance and general acknowledgement of the need for administration, faculty, staff, and students participating in the conduct of university affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee is charged to review and make final recommendations to the Commission on Undergraduate Studies and Policies concerning degree requirements, courses, academic progress, standards and criteria, and other policies and procedures affecting undergraduate curriculum and instruction; and

WHEREAS, the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee membership currently includes one staff representative elected by Staff Senate (three-year terms); and

WHEREAS, the Administrative and Professional Faculty Senate is not represented on the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee membership;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee membership be revised to add one administrative and professional faculty representative elected by the Administrative and Professional Faculty Senate (three-year term);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution will be effective immediately upon approval.
