# Presentation on Health Insurance at Virginia Tech

Presenters Rebecca Folmar and Amanda Marcum

- F-1, J-1 students, and students in the college of Medicine re required to have health insurance at the university. No other students are required to show proof of insurance to the university.
- Students can purchase Aetna through the university or healthcare outside of the university.
- The Aetna insurance coverage runs from August 1 July 31st every year and students must re-enroll every year for coverage.
- Prescriptions can be fulfilled at Schiffert health care center and this is often cheaper than other options.
- An annual eye exam is offered with a copay of \$15.
  - If you purchase glasses or contact lenses you can be reimbursed up to \$120.
- If you get a referral from Schiffert health care center for treatment elsewhere, your final costs will be decreased.
  - If Schiffert health center is closed and you need treatment you don't need a referral.
  - If you are more than 20 miles outside of Blacksburg, you do not need a referral.
  - Maternity services and those students enrolled in satellite campuses are not required to get that referral.
- Cost and enrollment
  - The cost of the Aetna plan is \$3,276 p/a
    - Students can pay this money upfront or choose an installment plan when they sign up.
    - If you are enrolled in 12 credit hours and have an assistantship you are eligible for a subsidy.
  - Enrollment deadline is on September 12 every year.

# Presentation on TimelyCare

Presenter Erica Coates

- TimelyCare is an online healthcare app that connects allows student to go to online health coaching, counseling, and have access to self-care content and have an on-demand function for students in moments of distress.
  - On-demand function

- The response time is around three to five minutes.
- The average length of an 'on-demand' talk is about 25 minutes.
- Online Counseling
  - Available in the United States
  - Students can schedule up to 12 appointments
  - Wait times are typically one week
- Student reviews of the app rate it as a 4.9/5
- Available as an app on your phone or on your computer.
- Registration is as quick as three minutes.
