Major Changes - SAFAB Policies apply to UCSOs (GPSS, USS, VTU, ...)

- Defining SAFAB for first time. It will report out its policy recommendations and allocations to the USS and GPSS
- Increasing flexibility so organizations can use funds as they see fit on items ranging from Decorations, Food/Beverage, Printing/Copying, Student Travel for Conferences, Wearing Apparel
- Centralizing standard needs including: office supplies, potentially food/beverage serving supplies
- Removing telephone since organizations aren't using this line item.

New Business: GSBB Policy First Reading

Policy for the Graduate Student Budget Board (GSBB)

- Increasing Food/Beverage cap to \$2,000 per year
- Guidance on insurance
- Adding programming supplies to support event specific items which are necessary to the function of the event and support the mission of the organization
- Increasing reimbursement rates for travel expenses
- Adding urgent summer decisions guidelines and streamlining the reallocation requests
