- Vice President
 - Many senators forget to sign in to meetings and/or do not attend.

Commissions/Committees Reports

- Commission for Staff Policy and Affairs
 - Working on updating the constitution and bylaws for the commission. They are also discussing educational opportunities for faculty, grad students, and students.
 The commission also runs walking tours that anyone can take if they are interested in history.
- CGPSA
 - Working on resolutions and policy changes.
- Climate Action, Sustainability, and Energy Committee
 - They are working to meet VTs sustainability goals but students wanting to contribute to this can register their interest
- CGPSP
 - Has not met since the last senate meeting (11.17.22)
- UAC
 - UAC has not met since the last GPSS meeting. But from an athletics perspective, our last football game was canceled. Come out to support our basketball teams and other sports (I believe Women's basketball is in the top 10 for the first time since 1999, and only the 2nd time in program history!). Men's basketball plays #1 UNC on Sunday at home
- CUSA
 - Signed off on their joint finance policy approval committee (SAPSC). So, they have our first joint subcommittee

Ad Hoc Committee Reports

- Health Insurance
 - o Hopefully, a survey will be sent out by the end of the semester
- Living Wage
 - Defining CoL method: \$32,431
 - There is a plan to increase the stipend level above the minimum in order to be competitive

Bookholders statement

- Virginia Tech students were paid below the minimum wage at Bookholders (a private business on Main St) but when they brought this to the attention of the Department of Labor, Bookholders brought a lawsuit against them
- The GPSS and USS are voting on whether to adopt this statement but the university currently has not offered the VT students involved any support

Cranwell International Center Presentation

- Rob and Vivian are here from the CIC
- Nationally international student numbers peaked pre-pandemic and VT is number one in the state form the amount of international students (including institutions such as GMU and UVA)
- International graduates students made up 60% of the total graduate population here at VT
- During the pandemic a lot of people left the field or were fired, so CIC has been trying to hire from staff for their office and they currently have two active searches going
- The CIC staff process the paperwork not only for current international students but also for graduates students who are on OPT or STEM OPT
- CIC sends out a biweekly newsletter through a listserv that details events and services
- Housing is difficult for graduate students
 - Suggestion: an online version of the housing fair that happens here for prospective students to begin understanding their options (I don't know how possible this would be)
